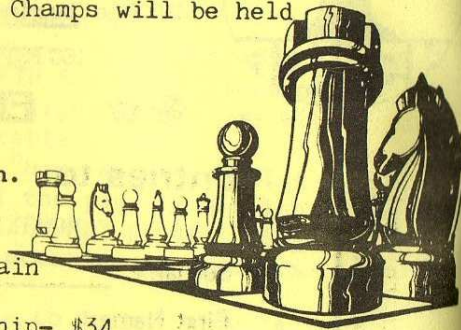

Dear Peter,

Following the article in June CIA regarding the \$1,000 Grace Bros Scisys chess competition I think your readers would be interested to know that the lead up qualifying rounds attracted over 400 entrants. Each entrant had to beat the Scisys Turbostar to qualify for the final. Out of 400 only 24 of Sydney's best players proved capable of beating the Turbostar, and several of those needed more than one attempt. This represents 96% wins for Turbostar and 6% losses during the qualifying rounds. The actual qualifiers were players of the calibre of Rogers, West, Hjorth, Flatow, Johansen etc. The bulk of the non qualifiers were club players who found the Turbostar too strong, and did not make it to the final. Most club players would be happy with a 96% win rate and I think this competition showed that Scisys Turbostar is a very powerful computer. Because of the terrific response to the tournament we will be running it again with Grace Bros. next year, as it is good for chess in general. Trusting you will publish this letter. With kind regards.

Tournaments that have been rated in this list are: Newcastle junior, City of Sydney (all divs), North Rocks w/e, Albury w/e, Western Subs Sterling Premiership, Hakoah Henry Greenfield Cup, Novag NSW u-18, u-16, Cent Coast Teams champ, Central Coast open, and club championships from Collegians, Ettalong, St George (5divs), Central Coast Leagues, White Knights, 1st cycle Big Teams, Hakoah training tourney.

The high percentage score required to win large Swiss system tournaments encourages cut throat play, leading to a low proportion of draws and often a high number of brilliancies - significant factors in the burgeoning popularity of international opens around the world.

In the Biel International Open this year the quest for brilliance was further encouraged by a 100 Sw Fr (\$60 A) plus banquet prize for the best game of each round. The winning games and runners up were published in the daily bulletin of the Interzonal. This month's Games Section features four of the best 'Torero Prize' entries from the Biel Open.

E. DIZDAREVIC (IM YUG) - A. MILES (GM ENG)

1 c4 b6 2 d4 e6 3 Nf3

A wise choice against Miles. After 3 d5 Qh4!? White might be able to keep a slight edge theoretically, but most of the theory is based on Miles' games!

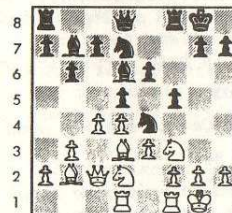
3... Nf6 4 e3

This and similar quiet systems have achieved a fair degree of popularity in Yugoslavia recently but Miles knows about them too, having a fine victory against Spassky to his credit on the black side of this opening.

4... Bb7 5 Bd3 d5 6 b3 Bd6 7 0-0 0-0 8 Bb2 Nbd7 9 Nbd2 Ne4 10 Qc2 f5

With remarkable ease black has achieved a fine attacking position - in fact white might have done well to copy black with 10 Ne5!?

However it is quite incredible that the innocuous text move should lose outright. White could have prevented the coming holocaust by exchanging on d5.

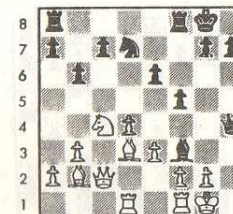
11 ... Nxd2! 12 Nxd2

12 Qxd2 dxc4 13 Bxc4 Bxf3 14 Bxe6+ Kh8 15 gxf3 (or 15 Bxd7 Qg5) Bxh2+ 16 Kxh2 Qh4+ 17 Kg2 Qg5+ 18 Kh2 Rf6 leads to mate - a typical single bishop sacrifice variation.

12 ... dxc4 13 Nxc4

Much the best recapture. White needs his second rank clear to use his queen for defence.

13... Bxh2+! 14 Kxh2 Qh4+ 15 Kgl Bf3!!

A new twist to an old theme. The immediate 15... Bxg2 would permit 16 f3! when white's queen can come to the rescue.

15... Bf3 threatens 16... Qg4 and therefore white has no choice but to block the second rank with 15 Be2 or 16 Nd2, since 16 gxf3 allows 17... Qg5+ and 18... Rf6 (again!) and 16 Rfe1 Rf6 followed by ... Rh6 also forces mate (if 17 gxf3, Qh3 etc)

16 Nd2 Bxg2! 17 f3

Forceed, and setting a little trap. 17 Kxg2 Qg4+ and 18... Rf6, and 17 f4 Qg3! offer no hope for white.

17... Rf6!

Avoiding 17... Qg3? 18 Ne4! when white would escape.

18 Nc4 Bh3 0 - 1

White has no defence to 19.. Rg6+ eg 19 Qf2 Rg6+ 20 Kh2 (20 Kh1 Bg2+) Qh5! followed by ... Bf1+ and mate.
