However with a small influx of new members; Harvey taking over as Treasurer, Alan stepping into the breach as D.O.P. and Phil picking up the pieces as secretary, the club has managed to stay on its feet.

The C.A.Q. came very close to folding up in the past year, due to inexperienced management and a recent history of strife. But the A.G.M. saw a completely re-structured executive- The Gap playing a supporting role and proposing Bill Powell as president, and a new fee structure aimed at reviving the disast rous membership situation, Clubs are now committed to affiliating all their members- hence the propositions on our agenda the yearly subscription is long overdue for revision, the committee proposes to pay the whole subsription to the C.A.Q. which will mean The Gap will return to the situation of five or six years ago where C.A.Q. affiliation was part of the subscription, week to week running expenses will be recouped from night fees.

A motion from the Gap resulted in this event reverting to the old formula of home and away games being played on club premises, most Brisbane chess players were introduced to open competition through this medium.

1992 should see club tournaments getting underway very shortly which will mean a full programme completed and the Best All Rounder awarded once more.

We could still use more members and if each one of us could bring in one it would see the club well on the way to a healthy position.
